- ☐ Most current transcript (unofficial transcript is acceptable) or, if you are a first term student, your acceptance letter into a university for the upcoming term. Term registration is required and must be reflected in this transcript or letter. Please contact LEO at info@laweo.org with questions or concerns about this requirement.
- ☐ A letter of recommendation for this scholarship from a teacher or business associate. This letter should be on their official letterhead and must contain contact information for this individual.
- □ A letter of interest including the following information, *authored by you*:
  - 1) Your name and current occupation or employment (as applicable)
  - Your intended occupation and why you are interested in this occupation; and a plan to reach your career goal
  - 3) Why you are applying for the scholarship and why you should be selected
  - 4) If you are a returning applicant or scholarship recipient, a statement of what you have done in the past year to support minorities (including BIPOC and women) in law enforcement, criminal justice and/or corrections
  - 5) Anything else about yourself or your accomplishments that you would like the committee to know when we are considering your application. Please craft this statement to be concise and not to exceed one page in length.

Please note: The LEO scholarship is a competitive scholarship and your application will not be considered if it does not fit these guidelines and is not received complete by the stated deadline. Scholarships are awarded in April. The scholarship award procedure includes an in-person interview (March) and an in-person scholarship award ceremony (April), both held in the Twin Cities Metropolitan area. Specific dates and times will be announced. Applications are accepted from October 1 to February 1.
